2024 New Fair Footprint

PROSPECTIVE FOOTPRINT CHANGES FOR 2024



Highlights:

- Summer Night Concerts will move indoors in the Coliseum.
- Superdogs will move to the Agrodome with additional staff directing pedestrian flow and seating.
- Toon City will move from the Playland Sanctuary area to Italian Gardens.
- Kids Discovery Farm will move from the Livestock barns to outdoor area near the Skate Park (West lawn area). Skate Park will remain open to the Public.

Traffic & Pedestrian Flow Impacts

Miller Drive


- To accommodate infrastructure upgrades, 500ft of Miller Drive north of the Amphitheatre Construction has been converted to one-way eastbound to accommodate space for greenway.
 - A dedicated 2-way pedestrian pathway running parallel is currently in effect.
- During events, Miller Drive has additional staff positioned to create 2-way controlled traffic.
- A possible closure of Miller Drive for approximately 1-2 weeks may be required with exact dates to be communicated in advance and shared publicly.

Other Site Flow Changes

The corridor between main line and Playland Point is being widened to create a higher capacity pathway linking the Fair footprint and Playland

Path will be approximately 25'- W 35' wide to help move 300-400k people between the east and west side of the park as main hill up to Playland will be closed. Completion expected by May 22.



Parking & Transit Plans

Current On-Site Parking

- Reduction in onsite parking due to Amphitheatre construction footprint until Spring 2026
- High volume of film crew bookings in parking areas on non-event days.
- Working with Racetrack to utilize overflow space on event days as required.
- Work with car share relocation services in area to increase available parking
- Lot 9C by Empire Fields & Playland to return to parking in June once Launch Coaster construction finishes

Fair Parking & Transit Plan

- Similar to previous years, on busy days, traffic will be diverted off Hastings down to Racetrack in-field for additional Fair parking
- All regular lots will be in use as in previous years.
- Staff parking offsite at school lots
- Discussions with TransLink underway for the return of Fair-time service. Service schedule to be confirmed.

Bikeshare Plan/Ride Share

- Ride share drop off available at Gate 2/6/9 yearround.
- Mobi bikes were installed across from Playland main gates July of 2023 through to Fright Nights but underutilized therefore these will not be installed for 2024 season.
- Bike racs available at all main entry gates

Neighborhood Clean Up & Public Safety Support


Community Support Programs
