AGRODOME:

This year we will not have access to the Agrodome. With the renovation of the Amphitheatre, the Summer Night Concerts will now be held in the Pacific Coliseum thus moving the Super Dog programing into the Agrodome. This leaves us with all programing for 4-H being done in the barns.

SCHEDULE:

Please make sure to review the schedule and locations of where your projects will be showing. The most noticeable change will be Beef/ Dairy and Llama.

MOVE IN / MOVE OUT:

Move in will begin on **Thursday August 15**th starting at 12:00pm.

Unloading will occur via the
Agrodome Compound (we do not have access to the inside of the
Agrodome), Miller Drive and Ag Alley.

PNE staff will be present to direct you. You MUST wait for a staff member to tell you where you will be unloading.

Move out will be **Monday August 19th**. We do ask that no one begins move out until *after* all auction animals are

loaded. Load out will occur through the <u>Agrodome</u> Compound Via Gate 6, Miller Drive and South end of the barns (Ag Alley). Again, we ask that you wait to be directed by a staff member to where you will be loading out. Please look on page 17 of the prize book for more info.
