Vancouver, B.C. — For the first time ever the PNE is introducing comedy into its much beloved Summer Night Concert series! **Gerry Dee**, one of the biggest and most popular comedians in Canada, is coming to Vancouver to perform on **Saturday, August 24**th on the Chevrolet Stage in the Pacific Coliseum.

Currently travelling North America on his "Gerry Dee: Funny You Should Say That" tour, the comedian has been delighting audiences for years, both on stage and on screen.
